Year 3	<p>Maths: subtraction continues. The children will be consolidating their mental subtraction strategies and applying their skills to worded questions.</p> <p>English: We will be learning about the most famous fossil hunter! Children will have a chance to share any of their own stories too about when they have found something interesting or precious.</p> <p>Topic: We have our Stone Age day on Tuesday 17th – so children are invited to dress up in warm Stone Age style outfits.</p>
Year 4	<p>Maths: We will be finishing off our addition and subtraction lessons looking at using estimating and the inverse to check answers and finding efficient methods as mathematicians work smart. They will be having a 3x tables test and then moving on to the 6x tables.</p> <p>English and Topic: Linking history and English, we will be exploring lives of poor Victorian children, the jobs they did and the dreaded workhouse. We will be using the beginning of <i>The Little Match Girl</i> to explore working Victorian children.
